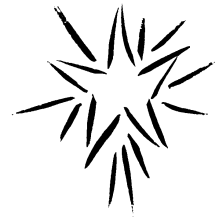


This week

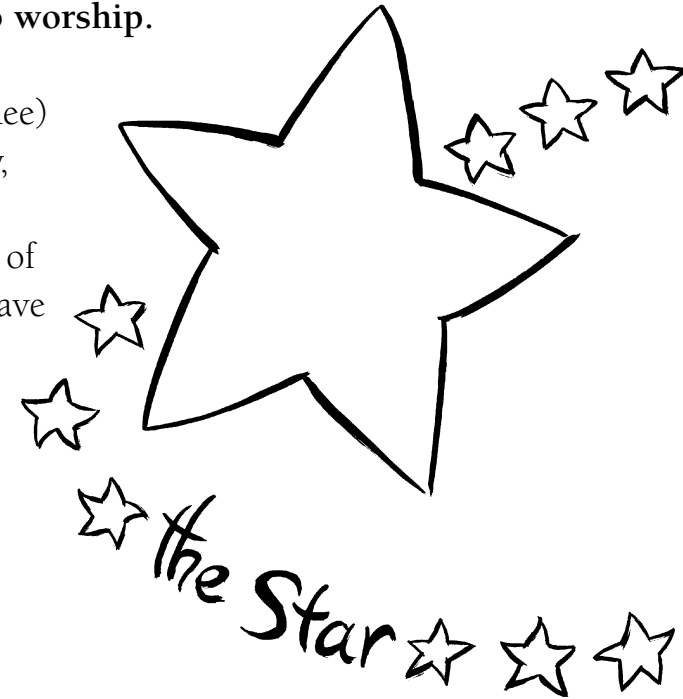
