Luke 11:1-13

The disciples asked Jesus to teach them to pray. Jesus taught them the Lord's Prayer. You can find the Lord's Prayer in the Bible (Luke 11:2-4 or Matthew 6:9-13). Followers of Jesus have added the last sentence to the prayer as a reminder that everything belongs to God.
