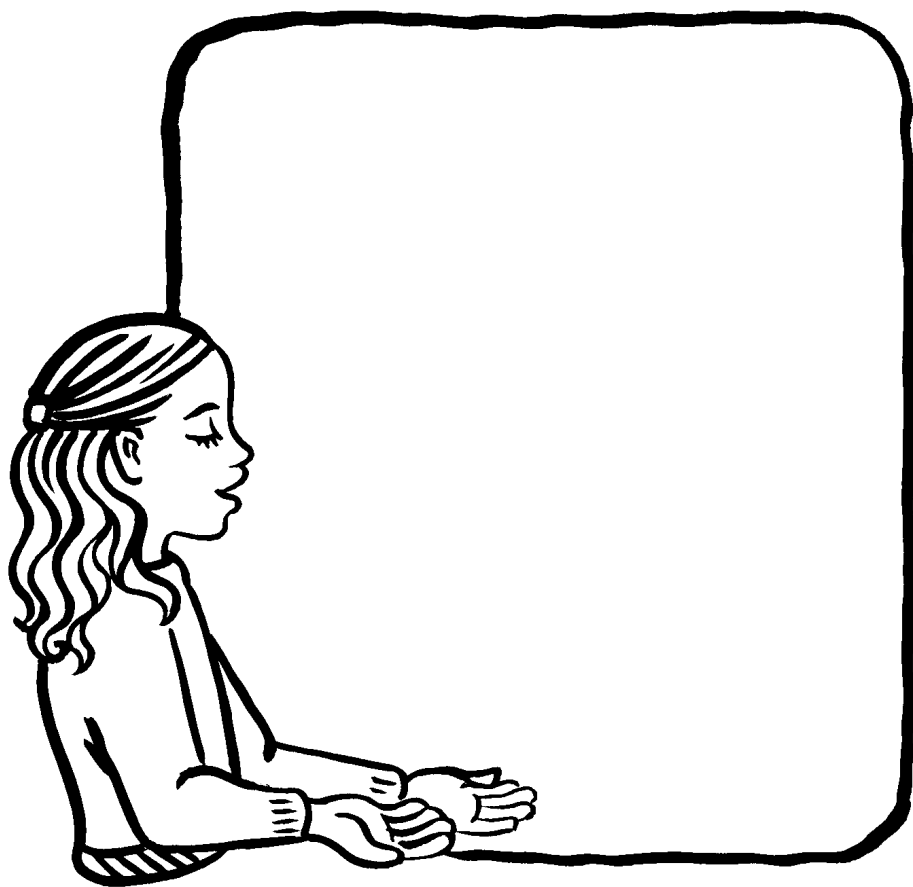

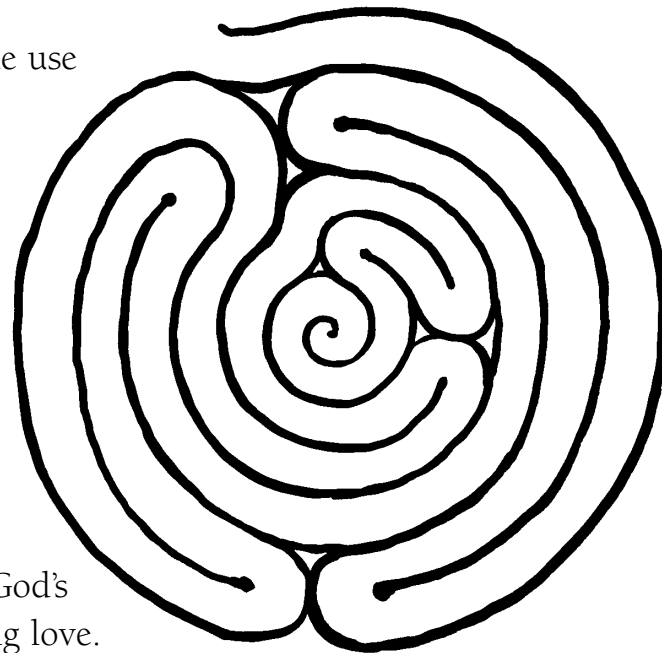
Find unusual places to pray along your way this week.

Use your finger to trace this circle path. When you finally reach the end you can begin again. Keep praying as you go on your way!

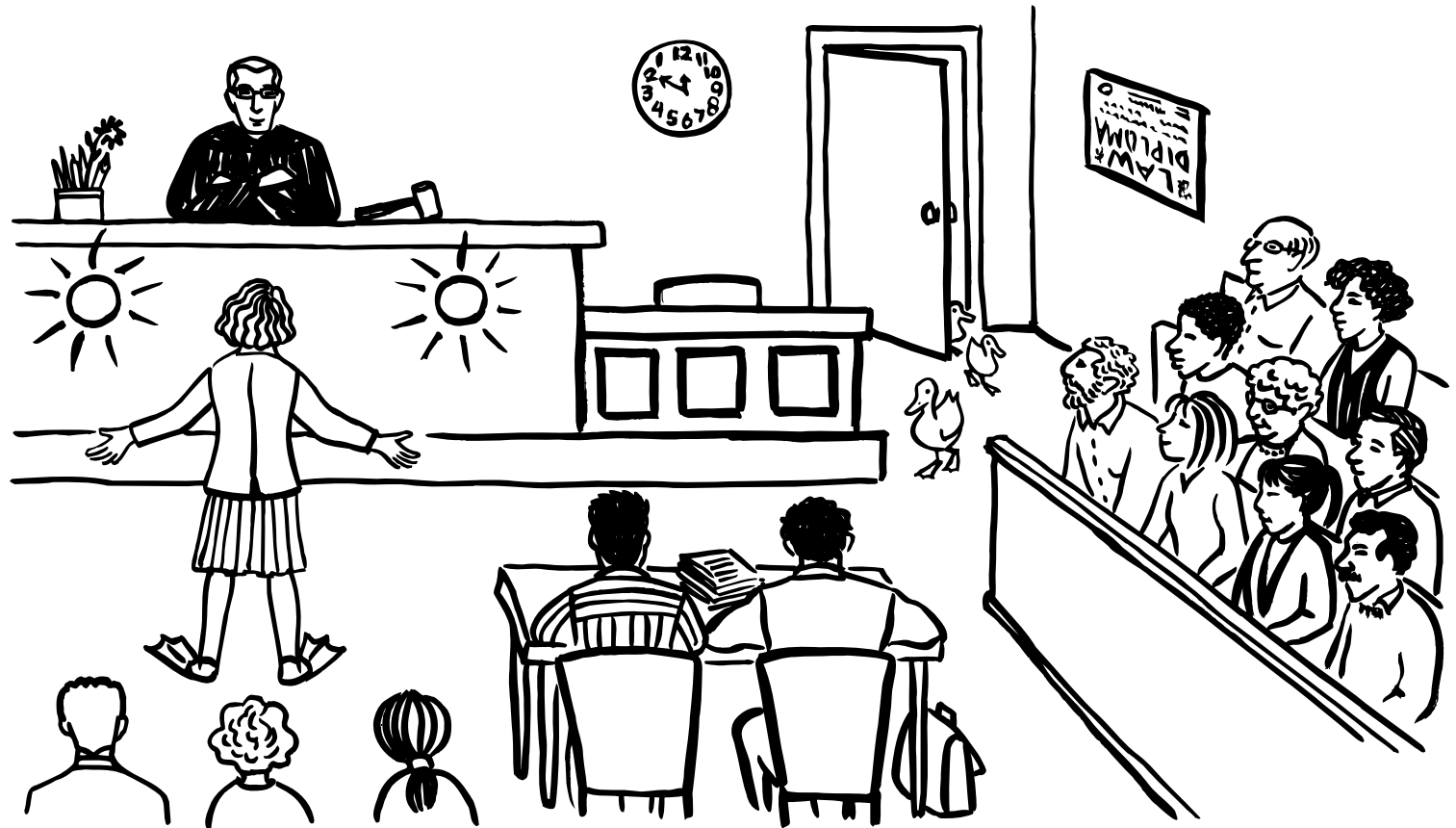
Surprising justice
