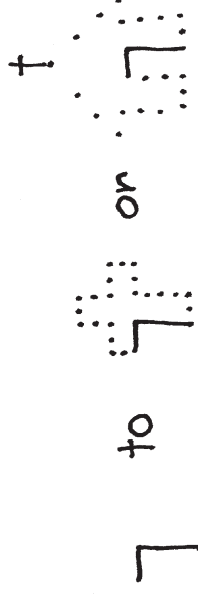
## This week
